**Supplying library cards through a collaboration between your child's school and Tompkins County Public Library!**



## How can I get a library card for my child through their school?

Simply complete the enclosed application (front and back). Include your Driver License number. Return the application to your teacher.

The school will then bring the application to the Library for processing and verify that the information is accurate. Applications must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.

The Library will process your application and mail your child's card to the address provided on the application.

\*\*\*\*\*

Library cards may also be obtained by returning completed applications to the Circulation Desk. A parent or guardian with proof of address must be present.

## What can I do with my library card?

### **Check out materials (a total of 50 items)!**

- Books for all ages and interests (up to 50 per card)
- DVDs (up to 5 per card)
- Audiobooks (up to 5 per card)
- Music CDs (up to 10 per card)
- Magazines (up to 10 per card)

### **Use the computers!**

- Early Learning Computers for our youngest users
- Internet Stations for ages 5-12
- Teen Computers for ages 13-17
- Tablets and eReaders
- Parent Internet Stations

### **Use our website to its fullest!**

- Place holds on library materials
- Check out eBooks or eAudiobooks
- Use our databases for access to many magazines and other research materials.
